### Ross Cutler and Amelia Clapton of Bunnings - Hawthorn

It was with pleasure we welcomed the manager of Bunnings, Ross Cutler and Amelia Clapton, Hawthorn's Activities Organiser, to our meeting on Tuesday. Bunning's have always been a great supporter of our club and it was an opportunity to hear more about how they interact with the community.

Ross was recruited from B and Q Limited in the UK and arrived for his first visit outside of his home land with his wife and two children aged 7 and 3.

Bunnings appealed to him because of the culture in the company and the wider opportunity it offered his family to have experience in another country.

Bunning's have 33,000 employees who try to help customers and small business with advice on everything from product to technical advice in construction.

From a corporate position, the company is actively working with organisations in the local community like the Salvation Army, Schools, Rotary and many more charitable institutions. The sausage sizzle they conduct has enabled them to return over \$110,000 to the local Hawthorn community. On a national level, over \$32 million was donated last year along with many hours of work by employees to support various charities.

Bunnings now source 40% of their products from Australia and do not support suppliers who use illegal methods such as child labour or timber that is not harvested from sustainable areas. Ross and Amelia both said they are only too willing to help Rotary in whatever way they can and would look at any proposal we put to them that would help the community.
