Objectives

The Rotary Club of Glenferrie will seek projects that support one or more of the following objectives, with priority given to projects that affect residents of the City of Boroondara:

- Help families
- Help the young
- Help the aged and those with disabilities
- Support the ideals and objectives of Rotary International by:
 - Helping the underprivileged
 - Promoting international goodwill
 - Improving healthcare
 - Promoting the concept of community service
 - Supporting projects consistent with the theme of the Rotary year as determined by the President of Rotary International

Attributes

Projects supported by the Rotary Club of Glenferrie will be prioritised, with preference given to those that have more than one of the following attributes:

- Be well planned
- Support organisations that are well managed
- Support individuals in their quest to improve the lives of others
- Provide opportunities congruent with our objectives that are not readily available elsewhere
- Show a direct, preferably measurable, impact to the service provided by the grantee
- Fund a project or program rather than an organisation's operating expenses
- Make a significant impact for the amount of money spent
- Promote "hands on" participation by our Rotary club members
- Enhance the identity/visibility of Rotary in the community
- Involve other organisations and stakeholders where appropriate
- Include provision for mutual communication and engagement
